



*Letter grade cutoffs:* The determination of your final letter grade will be no more strict than the following.

The cutoff for A+ is will be decided after the final exam, but A+'s will be a small "honorary" group. The decision has no GPA impact: an A+ counts the same as an A in the University GPA calculations.

*Attendance:* Regular attendance and participation is expected. The goal is to think about and work through mathematical proofs and problems together, confronting interesting and sometimes difficult new ideas.

*Homework:* Homework should be written up neatly and clearly—your goal is not merely to get an answer, but to write out a complete and concise solution. You are encouraged to work together on the homework, but the final write up should be done individually.

*Exams:* There will be two in-class hour exams and a two hour final exam.
